OILS <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Wooden Palette (preferable) or Disposal Palette- Palette knife- Odorless Tuppenoid with some kind of glass or metal container- Liquin Medium by Winsor Newton- Brushes:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Robert Simmons Sapphire or Grumbacher flat brushes -- size 2,4 and 6; and Robert- Simmons round brushes -- Sapphire sizes 1 or 2- Canvas: At least one canvas board or canvas on stretchers.<ul style="list-style-type: none">Suggested sizes: 11 x 14, 14x18, or 16x20	ACRYLICS <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Canson disposable palette or Masterson sealable palette- Grumbacher Retarder (to keep paint from drying too quickly)- Brushes:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- flat brushes - Shaders by Robert Simmons sizes 2,4,and 6- small round brushes – Robert Simmons Sapphire size 1 or 2.- Spray bottle for water- Canvases: At least one canvas board or canvas on stretchers.<ul style="list-style-type: none">Suggested sizes: 11 x 14, 14x18, or 16x20.
