

Supply List for Acrylic Techniques Workshop-June Skalak Instructor

Paints:

Acrylic paints - basic set of colors - substitutions OK but need the primary colors of a red, yellow, blue and white.

Titanium White
Ultramarine Blue
Cadmium Red Light
Crimson Red
Cadmium Yellow Medium
Lemon Yellow
Phthalo Blue
Dioxazine Purple

Painting Knife:

At least one knife: I like Liquitex Brand knives
#1 knife

At least two brushes:

Windsor Newton or other quality brush designed for acrylic painting
1/4 “ to 1/2 “ synthetic in a flat and/ or filbert
and

A glaze or wash brush such as Winsor & Newton Cotman, synthetic filament:
3/4” or larger “Aquarelles” or “Wash Brush”- approx 1”

Painting surface:

Acrylic Pads approx 9x12” or larger
and/or
Canvas Boards 8 x10” or larger. approx 6 surfaces for practicing techniques.

Palette:

paper plates, paper disposable palette or sheets of wax paper that can be taped to sturdy hard surface like a cookie sheet.

Mister or spray bottle for water -to keep paints damp.

The following 2 items can be purchased in class for a small user fee (\$2) if you donot want to purchase:

Impasto medium “Matisse” or other brand
and **Glazing medium**- “Liquitex” or other brand

paint rags or paper towels, water container and plastic or newspaper to protect tables in art center.
