

Multi-Media Art Journaling with Teresa Roberts Logan

SUPPLIES LIST:

Multi-media paper, such as two-ply Bristol Vellum 500 series OR a sketchbook – wirebound works well

Acrylic Paint, watercolors, pencils, or color media you like to work in

Paintbrush(es) - 1 large enough to paint the background of your paper, and another small enough for any detail work you want to do – detail work and lettering can also be done with permanent marker

Scraps of paper, magazines, fabric, teabags, colorful snack bags, clippings, quotes, color swatches – random things you like (for color, lettering, or subject matter), and could use to collage

Something to stick your images to the surface you've chosen: You can use Mod Podge, Gel Medium, Scrapbooking Double-sided tape, or a Gluestick (your preference, or all of the above!)

Scissors and/or X-acto Knife

Paint rag or paper towels

Black permanent markers (different size tips),

Optional but helpful: White paint marker (Elmer's makes inexpensive ones)
